Who we are looking for:

Volunteers to greet and direct visitors at farms, count visitor attendance, and generally assist the farms in hosting visitors. The ideal volunteer is reliable, enjoys spending time outside, and speaking with people.

Volunteers will need to provide their own transportation to a farm. Farms are located in Jackson and Union Counties. Some carpools may be available.

Must wear appropriate clothing for being outside on a farm including closed-toed shoes, sun and rain protection.

Volunteers are required to attend a short orientation session prior to the Farm Crawl.

In return for volunteering for a 3 hour shift, you will receive a car pass that can be used all weekend to visit other farms on the Farm Crawl.

If possible please contact us by September 3th so we can get you on the schedule. If you can't commit ahead of time, just let us know and we will try to work with your schedule.
